The Gaslini Institute offers an International Fellowship Program to candidates from across the world in an unparalleled range of paediatric specialties.

Our Fellowships are aimed at international postgraduate medical trainees who are already well advanced in their specialty training and are looking to gain sub-specialist expertise at a world-renowned centre of excellence.

The International Pediatric Fellowship Program welcomes doctors who have completed a degree in Medicine (minimum requirement), Residency in Pediatrics or in a subspecialty of the Scientific Areas of the Fellowship Program.

The programme requires an attendance of a minimum of 6 months, to a maximum of 2 years depending on the chosen Specialty/Unit.

- Department of Medical-Pediatric Sciences
- Department of Surgical Sciences
- Department Hemato Oncology
- Emergency and Acceptance Department
- Maternal-Neonatal Department
- Department of Services

The Fellow will be embedded in their chosen department and will be assigned a dedicated consultant mentor who will monitor and review their progress and will guide them in their learning and in gaining clinical experience.

The Fellow will be a fully involved and active member of the clinical team and will see and manage patients under the guidance of the senior staff, attending multidisciplinary meetings, ward rounds, clinics, operating theatres etc.

They will have every opportunity to take advantage of our range of formal teaching, lectures, Grand Rounds, and online training modules.

Fellows will be obliged to complete mandatory safety training courses.

About the Gaslini Institute

The Giannina Gaslini Children's Hospital is an academic medical Institute specialized in paediatrics that develops biomedical Research and is recognized by the Italian Ministry of Health as Scientific Institute of excellence.

Since its foundation in 1938 the hospital has been dedicated to children's healthcare and to finding new and better ways to treat childhood diseases..

Gaslini is the regional reference centre for the care of critically ill new-borns and operates the neonatal emergency transport service (STEN), it is the venue of the regional emergency department and national reference centre for the treatment of complex neonatal, paediatric and adolescent diseases requiring specialized medical and surgical care: more than 45% of patients come from other Italian regions and from abroad.

Entry requirements for the International Pediatric Fellowship Program

- Medical degree
- Two years or more of specialty training at the time of entry
- Postgraduate qualification in the chosen specialty is not compulsory but appreciated
- Full time clinical work during the year directly prior to their Fellowship start date.
- Knowledge of the English language equivalent to B2 CEFR
- A basic knowledge of the Italian language is highly recommended.
